HISTORY OF ANKUR SCHOOL

The idea of having a Nursery school on the Campus of P.U. was a long cherished dream of the resident, so all the members of the Student Aid society met and discussed the possibility and finally decided to work in this direction.

Mrs. Suraj Bhan carried on the idea of free school in the campus for the junior employee's children.

The PU Student Aid Society then embarked upon establishing Nursery school on modern lines, to provide quality education to young ones from the very start. The purpose was to fulfil long felt need of the parents residing in the campus as well as in the adjacent sector, for a Nursery school. It was thus, a welfare activity on the campus in the true sense of the term. Thus, Student Aid Society has remained a parent body. The school was named Ankur Nursery School, which got formally inaugurated on 25th February, 1973.

Following are the objectives of Ankur School.

- 1. To initiate or undertake any scheme for the welfare of the students.
- 2. To collect funds through donations, subscriptions, film shows in the university campus, dramas and organizing fetes etc. for providing aid to needy students.
- 3. To foster a spirit of social service amongst the members.

A number of welfare schemes were introduced to ensure quality education in the school.

STRENGTH & CHARACTER OF THE SCHOOL

Ankur was conceived of and planned as a Nursery school (Kindergarten). Ever since its inception, it was started with a mission of helping the poor children of the junior employees on the campus and surrounding sectors.

It is a non profit and self- sustaining institution.

Traversing a long journey of 42 years, it has earned a name and present status due to the dedication and commitment of Principals and teachers working in the school, under the guidance of all the Presidents and managing committee as follows.






LIBRARY












Our endeavour is to work with parents as a team and consider them as equal partners in the child's growth . Parent teacher meetings are held wherein the parents are updated about their child's learning graph. A regular interaction between the two contributes to the nurturing of a child.



TEACHER'S TRAINING

Teachers are attending various workshops and training programmes to update themselves with the ongoing syllabus. The regular intensive and inservice training programmes are held inhouse which helps them in understanding student psychology and behaviour. They are also trained in the use of smart class for more effective and interesting teaching.

ORIENTATION

Orientation meetings are held for the parents of all the classes before the beginning of the new session. In these meetings, we familiarise the parents to the school system, its policies, working and management.



Educational tours and trips by the professional travel agencies are arranged for the students of all the age groups to visit places of historical, cultural, scientific and economic interest. These tours increase their knowledge, self confidence, sharing and caring.



EXAMINATIONSYSTEM

Parents are apprised of the examination system at the time of the orientation meeting. The students are given circular regarding the detail of the examination in the beginning of the session along with the marking scheme.

PRE-PRIMARY

Students are evaluated on the basis of day to day activity and learning in the class.

CLASS I to VIII

- Mid Term examination in the last week of May.
- Pre Mid Term examination in mid September.
- Post Mid-Term examination in 2nd & 3rd week of December.
- Annual Examination in February .(I to III week)

CLASS IX-X

- Same as in Classes I-VIII.
- Pre Annual (IX) / Pre-Board (X) in the month of January after the school reopens.
- Class X students to appear for the Board Examination.


CLASS XI

SPORTS AT ANKUR

Sports form an integral and vital part of the school curriculum. The school provides facilities for all the games. Our endeavour is to encourage healthy competition, character building and physical stamina amongst students through sports. School has produced various National and State level winners. These sports are played at inter house and at inter school level.























SCHOLARSHIPS AND INCENTIVES

The bright and deserving students in academics as well as sports are awarded with various scholarships.

PRE-PRIMARY

- 1) Smt. Maitreyi Sharma Memorial Award for the best student of Nursery class (one time cash prize of Rs.500)
- 2) Seth Beniprasad Memorial Award for the Best student of K.G class (one time cash prize of Rs.500 every year) There are certain criteria for judging the deserving candidate for the above scholarships.





ACADEMIC AWARDS

- I- Scholar badges to be pinned up to all the students securing 90% and above marks in one academic session .
- 2- Students getting the scholar badges for three consecutive years to be given some incentive in the form of school bags or some good library books at the time of prize distribution ceremony.
- 3-The students attaining 100% attendance in an academic year will be awarded with certificates.





SPORTS AWARDS

- For national level winner cash prize of Rs.500 will be given as a scholarship per month. Along with, a merit certificate, a trophy and colour for the blazer for one year during the period when the student holds position as national level winner will also be given.
- For state level winner cash prize of Rs.250 will be given as scholarship per month. Along with, a merit certificate, a trophy and colour for the blazer for one year will also be given during the period when the student holds position as state level winner.
- For interschool level winner- certificate and trophy will be awarded for the year the child has won the competition.

HOUSE SYSTEM

To inculcate competitive spirit through activities among the students, the students community of the school is divided into four Houses. Every House is under the care of a teacher in-charge. Lot of inter-house competitions take place at curricular and extra-curricular level throughout the session. Prizes and certificates are given at the time of Prize Distribution ceremony.



THE SCHOOL COUNCIL

An Investiture Ceremony is held every year in the beginning of the session when a new student council is elected . They are elected every year on the basis of few criteria like punctuality, academic performance, performance in sports, attitude towards teachers and peer, participation in co curricular activities, leadership qualities.

The student council of Ankur School consists of Head Boy, Head Girl, Deputy Head Boy, Deputy Head girl, Captains, Vice captains and prefects of all the four houses who take care of the discipline as well as help in organising all the functions around the year.





DAY CARE CENTRE

NILAYA

(CRECHE)

The school provides fully air conditioned crèche facility for the working parents. It has caring and understanding support staff working under the guidance of the Principal. Separate bed rooms and washrooms for boys and girls, neat and fully furnished kitchen, big central hall with dining and reading facility are the highlights of the crèche. The ambience here is quite homely. We boast of having happy children here. The crèche also has the facility of different time slots for the working parents.









PRIMARY WING

The school understands that cheerfulness and happiness in the child come as a result of the security and confidence through their teachers therefore each child is treated here as a special individual. Saturdays are off for the Pre
primary wing.

SCHOOL DIARY

forms an important means of communication between parents and teachers. Parents must sign the diary every day. It not only contains the personal information, medical history of a child but also the code of conduct and school rules. Information about the school uniform, timings and other vital information can also be obtained from the school diary/almanac.



In order to be eligible for appearing in class X examination, as per CBSE rules, a student must have attended not less than 75% of the classes held in each subject. Students attaining 100% attendance for the academic session will get the certificate for their regularity.



REGISTRATION & ADMISSION PROCESS

Application for admission in the school must be made on the prescribed form attached with the prospectus.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- a) Copy of birth certificate with name
- b) One photograph with parents/ guardian (with date on it)
- c) Residence proof (self attested)
- d) Copy of Aadhar Card
- e) Copy of Vaccination Card/ Immunization Card

A). ADMISSION TO PRE-NURSERY.

Total number of seats = 120

- a). The admission will be given on the basis of draw as per orders of the District Education Office of U.T Chandigarh.
- b). 50 % seats have been reserved for the wards of PU and its affiliated college employees
- c). 25% of the seats are reserved for E.W.S

B). ADMISSION FROM CLASSES NURSERY TO IX AND XI (COMMERCE AND ARTS ONLY)

Admission to these classes depends on the availability of seats, If available then:

- 1. Students will be assessed in the month of February/March (Classes Nursery to IX)
- 2. Admission on the basis of Merit list after the assessment.
- 3. For class XI provisional admission to be given only to Ankur School students in the month of April (subject to regularisation in July).
- 4. The students from other schools who want to seek admission to class XI in Ankur School will be given admission in July only on the basis of Board exam result.





LEAVE AND RE-ADMISSION

Leave must be applied on a printed application form as supplied by the school. In case of sickness and post dated sanction, certificate from a qualified doctor is must. Name of the student will be struck off from the rolls of the school in case there is an unexplained, continuous absence for 10 days or leave having not obtained in advance.

If the fee is not deposited till 3 lst of the fee month then the name of the child will be struck off (Kindly check the fee booklet also for the rules)

In case of re-admission he/she can be re-admitted by paying re-admission fee as mentioned in the fee booklet.

RULES FOR WITHDRAWAL

- I. A student who wishes to leave the school must apply in writing to the Principal.
- 2. The application must be countersigned by the parents.
- 3. A month's notice or one month's fee in lieu has to be paid when a student is to be withdrawn.
- 4. Those who leave the school in May, must in all cases pay the fee for the month of June of the current academic session.
- 5. School leaving certificate will be issued only after the student has cleared all the dues.
- 6. Caution money will be refunded on clearing of all the dues.
- 7. Caution money if not claimed within 6 months of withdrawal of the child may be subject to forfeiting and deposited in the school account. This money will be spent for the welfare of the students.
